Motion to accept the Spring Meeting Minutes. 2nd. Accepted

Guests: Newly elected Department Commander, Eddie Asberry, Post 296, Marietta

Eddie wanted to thank everyone for coming and thanked everyone for allowing him to serve in the upcoming year. Eddie's goal this year is for unity. The American Legion as one and everyone giving support to each member of the family. We have not met the Commander's Project goal for the last few years, so Eddie has decided to amend the goal to \$75,000 instead of \$100,000 and he's asking us all to help him exceed that goal this year. He thanked Tony and all the Area and District Directors for their support.

Director's Report - Tony Propst

- Currently we have 44 ALR Chapters in the state with membership of 1,046. 611 are Legionnaires, 212 are Auxiliary and 223 are Sons of the American Legion. We added a Chapter at Post 137, Darien this year and hope to add additional Chapters.
- We had six Chapters qualify for the 100% Participation Streamer this year. Three Chapters missed out by one event and three missed out by two events. The Ride for America will replace the Cliff Rouse Ride this year as an optional event.
- Motorcycles are "toll-exempt," but must be registered on an active Peach Pass account and have a Peach Pass transponder mounted inside or on the vehicle to use the Georgia Express Lanes. You can sign up for a Peach Pass account by calling 855-PCH-PASS (724-7277). Each vehicle in a household must be registered for a separate Peach Pass transponder. However, households with multiple vehicles can opt to list those vehicles under one Peach Pass account. To open a Personal Toll Peach Pass Account, you will need the following information:
 - o Name, address and a contact phone number
 - Your driver's license number
 - Year, color, make, model and license plate number of vehicle(s) needing a Peach Pass
 - An initial payment of \$20 to open the account in the form of credit/debit card.
 - o A valid active credit card or debit card for replenishment of your account.

 - Day 1 Lady Lake, FL; Lake City, FL; lunch at Post 13 Valdosta; Waycross visit to Post 517, wreath laying, dinner and overnight.
 - Day 2 Milledgeville for lunch and wreath laying at Georgia War Veterans Home; Gainesville for dinner at Post 7 and overnight.
- Please send your ALR event information and/or flyers to Tony for the website. If you would send those copies to him in PDF format it would be greatly appreciated.
- If you would like to have a member of the Executive Board or Tony install your Chapter Officers, please contact them immediately. First come, first serve.
- Tony stated that it has been an honor and privilege to serve the past two years as State Director. We all need to continue to work and make Georgia the very best ALR organization in the country

Area Assistant Director - Mike Burwell

- Ride for America had over 1,000 motorcycles and no accidents. He said it was one of the safest rides around. It was \$10 for a rider and \$5 for a passenger.
- Atlanta Veterans Day Parade will be held on Saturday, November 9, 2019. Last year we had 11 chapters represented. We are hoping for a larger turnout this year. More on this later.

- Girl's State We sponsored 10 girls at Girl's State and this was the ALR's first visit to Girl's State. We hope to do it every year.
- This is Mike's last meeting as an Area Director. He has done it for five years and for personal reasons he must step

Finance Report: - Stanley Franklin

- Stanley took a few minutes to personally thank the riders for an outstanding job. Thousands of dollars were donated, and the riders rode thousands of miles. The riders can always be counted on to help whenever it is needed. Stanley is only a few hours away from retiring his position as Department Commander and the riders have mad him very proud this year. Sponsoring 10 boys for Boys State and 10 girls for Girls State was fantastic.
- Stanley did not have a report to send out to everyone as the legion has requested that we start changing our
 report so that it coincides with the legion's financial report. It will take June and July to move things around and
 create our budget for next year using the same guidelines. In the meantime, he provided us with the following
 recap.

 Money deposited over the year: \$36,729.14
 Money disbursed over the year: \$23,782.12
 Current balance: \$12,947.02

- The ride to Girls State was the first ever to Girls State and we will make it a yearly visit. We were greeted with open arms and it was a great experience.
- Larry mentioned the Legacy Run and reminded everyone that it would be stopping in Valdosta. He encouraged everyone to think about doing the ride, even if it is just for a day. The ride is coming through Georgia this year and it does not happen very often. It is a great experience and a wonderful feeling of accomplishment.
- The National Commander's Escort April next year seems to be a good possibility. Route is still tentative. Further information will be provided as time gets closer.
- Old Soldier's Day Parade First Saturday in August, August 3rd. We get to lead the parade and it is a great time. We must be there at 8:00 am because we lead the parade. Varsity hot dogs and cokes are served at the conclusion.
- Rider's Retreat We are looking at some time in May or June next year. We hope to have something definite on that soon
- Centennial Ride We talked about having a Centennial ride to visit all 34 posts. We are having a Passport book instead. The book will have a place for you to get it signed and/or place a picture at each post. When you have completed 80% of the listed posts you will receive a passport patch. You will have a year to complete this. The Centennial Passport will be a fundraiser and will cost \$10.00.
