DOG Treasurer's Finance Report: Jim Fultz

• Introduced himself by noting he was appointed by DOG ALR Director, Johnny Brown upon the death of Past Department Commander & DOG ALR Treasurer, Stanley Franklin. It was discovered that most of the records held by Stanley were kept on a computer that his wife could not access. In going back and retracing some steps of what was done, it was discovered there was \$11,731.64 in Regions bank. Due to reasons unknow at this time, the bank closed the DOG ALR account. Both Jim Fultz and Johnny brown set up a new account at Truist Bank (formally know as Sun Trust). The Director, Johnny Brown has authorized three signatures on the account (himself, Jim Fultz and Past DOG ALR Director, Tony Propst. The current balance on the new account is \$11,958.61. The different balance between the old account vs the new account is due to a deposit of \$326.67 (2 checks: \$160.00 & \$166.67) from Wreaths Across America. Before the old Regions account was closed, new checks were ordered at the cost of \$32.00, which has just been reimbursed. This transaction included within the current balance on the new Truist account of \$11,958.61.

Motion to accept pending audit, Tony Propst – Second – discussion (were all checks received from WAA? Confirmed YES) – Motion carried by raised hands, Approved!

DOG Director - Johnny Brown

- Post 29 Director, Jeff Garland asked & received confirmation that all his reports have been received by 5th District Director Thea Fultz.

- Area Reports
 - Area 1: Individual Chapter reports given to DOG ALR Director by Area Director not able to attend meeting.
 - Area 2: Director worked on Veterans Day Parade in ATL, location moved from downtown ATL to around The Battery (Braves Stadium) for months. Discussions with Parade officials finalized 5 days before parade with confirmation of ALR involvement, but at the back of Parade. That information was relayed back to Chapters and after receiving minimal interest in participating, it was concluded by DOG ALR Director we would not ride (walk bikes) in the rear of parade which would cause damage to bikes. This was explained to Parade officials per DOG Director. Past Director Tony Propst, for several year we and other MC groups led this parade. When change was made to Truist Park (The Battery), it also changed the Parade Director who was uncooperative and knew nothing of motorcycles and why we were moved to the back. Because this was a 100% Participation event for the state, looking now to replace with another event. There has been no reporting from District 3 or four. Recruiting & Retention:





- Need to recruit younger members into the Legion, Aux, SAL then ALR.
- o Need to build interest in the American Legion to the potential new members.
- The goal is to increase membership and retain who we have (keep applications with you)
- o The younger members are the key to the survival if The American Legion
- Directors must plan more rides not just meetings.
- Take advantage of recruiting at events

Question: can we get a list of discharged veterans in our state?

Answer 1: It was mentioned by a member who is a former recruiter, you can go to any recruiting offices who have detailed lists of veterans who served their time. A military installation will not give that information.

Answer 2: Director, 294 has gone to various forts and cautions that many who are being discharged may not be staying in your area or state. He added, they create a flyer that shows what the ALR is about, their upcoming rides/events as well as others in the surrounding are. They are distributed in motorcycle shops or places they are allowed. They have also added a QR code on the flyer that would take them directly to their post ALR page.

Question: How do you do/get a QR Code?

Answer: though the Google page, it will take you to the webpage.

- When using the ALR logo, confirm it is the sanctioned logo before distributing flyers or notifications.
- If you have a planned ALR Ride/Event, send your flyer and information to (DOGALR.org) and it will be posted to the DOG ALR webpage for the state.
- Donations/ Raising Money: We still have Caps, coins, vest patches, decals, 50/50 tickets, which need to be sold so
 we can build the account back up. Any items needed let DOG Director know (you send a check and DOG will send
 items. These items will also be on display at convention. The 50/50 will be drawn at the June convention. Pick up
 some 50/50 for your chapter/district on the way out.

• National Commander's Escort:

The National Commander will visit Georgia Apr 16 to Apr 19. A major event of the ALR is to escort him around the state during his stay and a greater honor to be one of the Posts that host a visit. It's a chance to meet the National Commander and get one of his pins for your vest. All are welcome to ride, even if it's only for one or a couple of legs or the remainder of the escort.  - Past Director Propst noted that coming to Duluth is an issue for many riders. I.e...those coming from Valdosta.
 - There is discussion of moving Dept meeting closer to the middle of the state, but we remain on contract in Duluth for a couple more years
 - A committee has been formed to look at changing 2 conferences into one mid-winter conference around December/January. Then the June Convention.
